A Word from the Pastor

Dearly beloved in Christ,

Greetings to you in the most precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

Here, we are in the midst of lent season. It has helped us immensely on our spiritual journey for the renewal. Last month I shared about the cross as a symbol known as a scandal, a mystery, a faith and a symbol of redemption and glory. This month our meditation will be much more closer way to understand Jesus as our Lord and Saviour in the light of his passion, death and resurrection. This year also special meetings are arranged for the passion week, meditation on the seven words spoken by our Lord on the cross on Good Friday and a United Easter Sunrise Service at Baldwin School grounds and Easter service at the church. We invite you to participate in all these special worship services and be blessed by the Lord. During this season we are also concerned about our children who will be having holidays. You will be happy to send them for vacation Bible School (VBS). We want you, along with your children to be part of this ministry.

Dear friends as I was pondering what to share in my pastoral letter, I was reminded the message of the cross and resurrection. It is common to meditate in the theological aspect of our faith. But what we learn from the situation and apply to our life situations is very important.

When Christ died on the cross, "the curtain of the temple was torn into two from top to bottom. The earth shook and the rock split". The tombs broke open and the bodies of many holy people who had died were raised to life" Mt 27:51-52. Here I want to share about the curtain of the temple torn into two. It opened the holy of holy which was not visible to common worshipper in the temple, now any one could see. There are no barriers between God and Man. Now the Holy Father is known to mankind through Saviour Jesus Christ. We the followers of Christ, do we have any barriers among ourselves?

I was reading "Still waters, deep waters" by Rowland Crouchers, Editor for Meditation. I was impressed by the narration of 'running with angles' laughter'. As scripture says , "there is no

condemnation for those who are united with Christ Jesus, because in Christ Jesus the life giving law of the spirit has set you free from the law of sin and death.... nothing in all creation that can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord" Rom 8:1, 38-39

Let me share the illustration the author narrates about Martin Luther Kings' Sermon. 'A knock at the mid night. The racial discrimination stopped the black Americans to travel in buses in Montgomery, Alabama, they started voluntary car pool. It became very successful and popular in city. The mayor, Gayle seeked the help of legal department so that he could stop the successful car pool operation which affected bus boycott. A hearing was set for November 13, 1956.

The historical verdict was pronounced by the United States Supreme court through the court release: the court of the USA unanimously ruled bus segregation unconstitutional in Montgomery, Alabama. It brought tearful joy in thousands of Black Americans. "The dearest hour of our struggle had become the first hour of victory. Some one shouted from the back of court room, 'God Almighty has spoken from Washington".

Such discriminations, disparities are common in our societies, caste & creed. We are his followers 'who brought the love and harmony in the society through his suffering and sacrifice. You need to be his 'Catalyst' so that the kingdom of God could be established amidst the people. You need to have love of Jesus and look around your work place, society, school and colleges and even in your families. Where subtle discrimination or barriers may be there. It may be male-female have and have nots, educated or uneducated, linguistic affinity or girl child discrimination. The death of Jesus removed the barrier between people and God in the temple. Let us take inspiration through this and strive to bring His kingdom on the earth. May the cross and resurrection of Jesus empower you in this season to become 'His People' so that you could be worthy of His calling, "you are the light of this world, salt of the earth" Mt 5:13-16. Unto that end may God bless you.

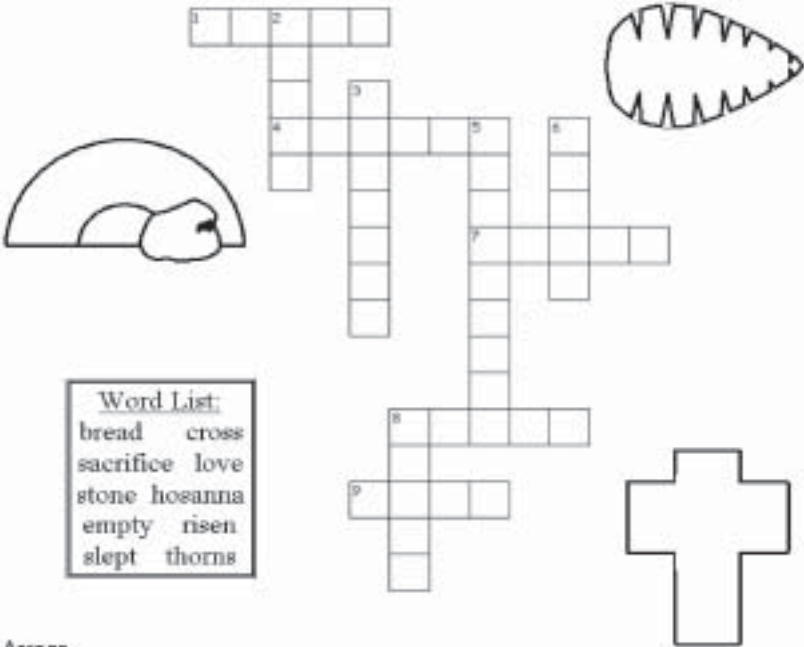

LAZARUS

THE APOSTLE TO FRANCE



It was the plan of God, after the ascension of the Lord Jesus Christ, to spread the Gospel to almost all, the then known world.[Middle East, Europe, Africa and Asia]. Thomas evangelized India, Matthew-Ethiopia, Mark-Egypt, Andrew-Russia etc. All that we know from the New Testament is that Jesus visited Mary, Martha and Lazarus at Bethany several times and Jesus raised

Lazarus from the dead. Many people came to Bethany to see the 'risen' Lazarus and to believe in the Lord [John 12:1-3]. This is the New Testament history, as we read from the Bible.

Then what happened to Lazarus? He is no longer mentioned in the Bible.

God used Lazarus in remarkable ways. The historical and archeological findings, very clearly tells us, how the Lord made use of Lazarus and his beloved sisters in Christ's urgent mission. The 'Diaspora' of the early Christians was the driving force to spread the Gospel. The tradition says that Lazarus became a prominent figure in the growing church, at Jerusalem, which was successfully functioning at Mary's house[House-Church], who was the mother of John Mark.

Because of the persecution in general and the Pharisees were planning to kill Lazarus in particular [John 12:9-12], Lazarus, Mary and Martha sailed to Cyprus in 49 AD. Paul had already established a small church at *Kittium* in Cyprus and Lazarus began to expand the church, a great deal and stayed there to establish the church on solid foundation. He became the Bishop of *Kittium*. Mary and Martha also served in the diocese.

The call came to Lazarus to move on to France in 63 AD and all the three moved on to *Marseilles* in France. He later on became the Bishop of Marseilles and his friend Maximinus [one among the seventy-two disciples, who accompanied Lazarus] became the Bishop of Aix. Even

today one can see the statue of Lazarus, which was excavated under St.Victor, the cathedral, in Marseilles. A huge church is seen in the basement of St.Victor, typical of first century architecture and on one corner stands the statue of Lazarus, looking up into heaven and below the statue are two boulders taken from the tomb from where he was raised to life. Mary served as the anchoress for the church, on a high mountain, where she lived and died. Martha founded a convent [world's first] and was helping Lazarus in his routines. The church of St.Martha at Trescon is a monument to her, in France.

God ordained the ministry of Lazarus, Mary and Martha, to accomplish the 'Great Commission'. Are we willing to participate in His great commission, in one way or other ?

Have you ever wondered why a pigeon walks so funny? It's so it can see where it's going. A pigeon's eyes can't focus as it moves so the bird actually has to bring its head to a complete stop between steps in order to refocus. It proceeds clumsily head forward stop head back stop.

In our spiritual walk with the Lord, we have the same problem as the pigeon. We have a hard time seeing while we're on the go. We need to stop between steps to pause and refocus on the word and the Will of God. That's not to say we have to pray and meditate about every little decision in life. But certainly our walk with the Lord needs to have built into it a pattern of stops that enable us to see more clearly before moving on.

Daniel's practice of praying three times a day was an essential part of his walk with God (Daniel 6:10) what about us? Let's learn this valuable lesson from the pigeon "Looking good" isn't nearly as important as seeing well"
