A Word from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved,

Greetings to you in the most precious name of our Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ.

This month, we are privileged to meditate on the triumphal entry of Jesus, His last discourses in the temple, the arrest of Jesus in the garden of Gethsemane, His trials in the night and crucifixion on the cross at Calvary, death and resurrection. While focusing on these, I would like to share about the disciples.

These disciples were not well educated but they obeyed the call and followed Him. Peter, John and James were fishing when Jesus called them "Come, follow me and I will make you fishers of men". At once, they left their nets and followed Him. In this way, He chose 12 disciples from different walks of life. He taught them about the 'Kingdom of God'. The final happenings shocked them all. After the arrest of Jesus, they were terrified. Peter tried to follow Jesus during the trial in the night but ended up denying Him thrice before the cock crew. Thus, the disciples became perplexed not knowing what to do after His death.

On the first day of the week when some of the women went to the tomb to perform the last rites, they were amazed to see the tomb open. The angel of the Lord appeared to them and said, "He is not here. He is alive as He has promised". Hearing this news, they ran back to the disciples and told them what they had seen and heard.

These happenings made the disciples much worried, not knowing what to do. They were afraid of the Jews and locked themselves in the room. Suddenly, Jesus appeared to them in the room and said, "Peace be with you". He showed them His hands and His wounded side.

Let me share a little about Thomas who was not there when the Lord appeared to the disciples in the room. He said "unless I put my hands in the hands and wounded side of the Lord, I will not believe". The Lord appeared when he was there with the disciples and said to Thomas, "because you have seen me, you have believed, Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." (John 20:29). We too are blessed people because we believe in the resurrected Lord.

This disciple Thomas visited India at St. Thomas Mount in Chennai, where the traditions say and believe him to be martyred. Also, the churches in India were established by him.

In the post resurrection experiences, Peter had the unique opportunity to be restored while he went back to his old profession of fishing, not knowing what to do. But the Lord reassured him and accepted him and gave him the responsibility to 'feed the sheep'.

If you are the one who denied him in any form or way when it was called for, you still have an opportunity to come back to Him. He will use your talents and gifts for His glory.

Next forty five days he appeared to them and reassured them with His presence. The experience with the resurrected Lord completely

transformed the disciples. Peter took up the responsibility to feed the sheep. On the day of the Pentecost, Peter was daring enough to say, 'You have crucified the Lord, but God glorified His Son and raised Him from the dead. Believe in the Lord and be saved'.

Henceforth, these disciples were not afraid of death. They preached about Jesus, baptized those who repented and believed in the Lord. Thus, they became extraordinary people witnessing unto the Lord. May this faith be yours too.

In the light of His passion, death and resurrection, may the Lord enable you to be transformed – His people.

May this Easter be yours.

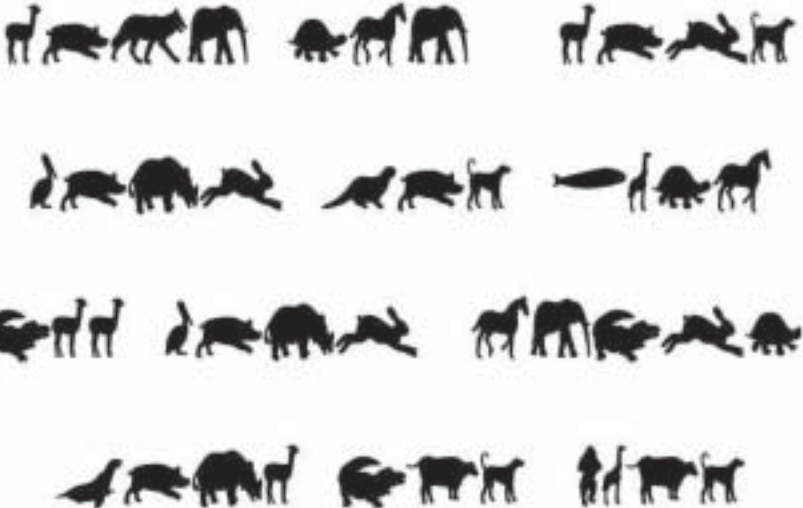

Your Question

What is our response when our non-Christian friends offer us 'prasadam' offered to their gods? What does the Bible say about this?

Christians who are working in secular environment encounter this issue especially during Hindu festivals. And I have helped some people to handle this situation wisely without hurting anyone. Eating food offered to idols was one of the main issues the Apostle Paul addressed while writing to the churches in 1 Corinthians. He discussed this issue at length in 1 Corinthians 8 to 10. He also discussed this matter in Romans 14 and Acts 15.

The Apostle Paul mentions three places where food offered to idols will be served. 1. Temples 2. Houses 3. Marketplaces. A Christian under no circumstances can eat inside "an idol's temple" (1 Cor 8:10). This public act will dishonor Christ and discourage new Christians who have denounced idols to serve the living God. But when invited to a meal of a non Christian friend, we can go and eat "asking no question" (10:27). No true friend will try to trap us like Balaam or Jezebel (Rev 2:14, 20). Next comes what is sold in shops. Muslims chant a prayer before butchering animals. Hindus place sweets and savories in front of pictures of gods and goddesses immediately after making them in restaurants and shops. We need not to bother about these things but can freely buy and "eat whatever is sold, asking no questions because the earth and all its fullness belong to our Lord! (10:25-26). Everything is sanctified by the word of God and a prayer of thanksgiving (1 Tim 4:4-5). That is the reason; we should never forget to pray before eating in our homes and hotels! If you feel shy to pray loudly, at least pray quietly in your heart before eating anything outside your home. If you haven't done it before, start praying from today.....

However, if you are invited to dinner and someone there says, "This food was offered to idols," then graciously refrain from eating. We are to avoid doing things that would make our friends to think less about our Christian faith or would make an unbeliever to feel satisfied in his/her sin. Moreover Paul makes it clear that though an idol is nothing to a Christian, according to the idol worshipper the food becomes sacred when offered to idols. Therefore, no Christian can accept 'prasadam' or food from an idol-worshipper if it is given in this sense or with this understanding (1 Cor 10:20 - 27). **You can politely refuse it with a smile.** But if you are forced to receive, don't fear and don't fight....receive it but don't eat...feed the birds on your way back home.

It is very important to communicate our Christian convictions and beliefs to our non-Christian friends and colleagues. So that no true friend will force us to eat anything offered to their idols. But if we are scared to communicate our Godly convictions to our non Christian friends, then we may compromise with the world and try to justify our action and lose our Christian testimony. I strongly believe that we who love the Lord must not partake in idolatry in any form and through any means. May the Lord help us to be like Daniel who resolved in his heart not to defile himself with the royal food (Dan 1:8) which includes food offered to Babylonian idols. Our relationship with God is much more important than our friendship with the World.

Testimony

Dear Friends,

Once again I want to testify that mine and your Sovereign God is a God of amazing grace, God of miracle & God who is in control of everything. His promise, 'I will never leave you nor forsake you' shows His love & concern for His children. A few years back when my husband had cerebral stroke, God spared his life with little deformities. This was one of the greatest miracles of my life.

This time to begin with, this storm started in a very subdued way but it turned out to be a biggest storm of my life. My **Jehovah Rophe** which means the one who heals, stood with me & my family. This thing happened in the last week of November 2011. The date of gallbladder operation of my husband was fixed for Friday. His entire pre-operation tests were normal. A few friends of us who are my husband's peer said that it is a minor operation that he would come out of the hospital within 5 to 6 days. And the same week on Thursday, our Pastor Paul Royappa visited us, I cannot forget his words, he said somebody inside me told me to visit you & pray with you. We were surprised since nobody knew the time & day when we have to go for the operation. Pastor prayed beautifully, me & my husband & family were very much encouraged. That was the first sign that **Jehovah Rohi** is with us to direct us in this journey.

Pastor Royappa asked me shall I announce from pulpit, but in my folly I told him no pastor Christmas season is starting everybody is busy in celebration. After 4-5 days we will come back from hospital & I will give my testimony. How much wrong I was rather vain. I failed to take hint from my Lord that big storm is coming and to strengthen you I am sending my ambassador to pray with your family & put you in the right path. On Friday, doctors took him to the operation theatre and it lasted for almost 2 hours. They brought him back to the room saying operation was successful.

My husband was in lot of pain as it was expected after operation. But very next day after checkup they told us that everything is not as

expected & he has to go to ICU since liquid is collected in the right side of his chest cavity. From that day onward it was just the whirl wind of suffering, pain & defeat. It lasted for almost 17 days. I used to sit in the hospital lobby waiting for the visiting time. Evil one was attacking us from all side as if he was bent upon breaking our faith & ashamed us before **Jehovah Nissi** which means God is our banner & victory. In my prayer I used to cry out to my Lord & always used to claim from God the promise which He gave to His children, 'I will not test you more than you can endure'. Slowly my husband's condition started improving. Lots of friends & well wishers visited us & prayed for us in hospital. I am ever so thankful to all of them.

I want to mention especially about sister Jamuna Jeyasingh & Prem James both on different days visited us & prayed. Their prayers were so much powerful that not only we but other patients in ICU, non-believers were touched by their prayers. The power of prayer came from the heart: I am very much thankful to Shobha Vijayakumar & our Senior Pastor who in spite of their sister critically sick never forgot us in their prayer.

Dear Rachel & Pastor Royappa daily used to pray for us. I am overwhelmed & humbled by their concern for their congregation. After 5 days we came back from Colombia Asia hospital where my husband was treated. One evening I got a call from Mrs. Nathan a good friend saying switch on the TV on News 9. As I switched on the TV, Colombia Asia hospital was engulfed in fire. People were running everywhere; hospital authorities were trying to shift patients to other hospitals. Just imagine if this incident happened when my husband was in the hospital & in ICU where nobody is allowed to stay overnight, to go from Indiranagar to Hebbal with traffic problem. What would have been our condition? Mrs. Nathan said another miracle in your husband's life. All praise and honour and glory to my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ.

Dear friends however big storm in one's life be. Our Lord is much bigger. Have you given your storm to God?
