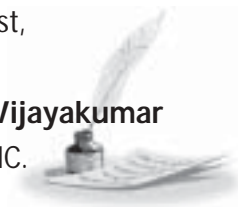
God also does not want his children to be slaves to Satan. When we commit sins, we become slaves to Satan. In his own grace, God sent his son to

Missionary Biography

BISHOP HERBERT PAKENHAM WALSH

BORN: 1871 DIED: 09.01.1949

Bishop Herbert Pakenham Walsh was born around 1871, the son of an Irish Bishop – who laid the greatest emphasis on evangelism. He studied in famous institutions at Chand, Birkenhead and finally at the Trinity College, Dublin, Ireland. He was a very bright student, with wide interests and a great sense of 'Irish' humour.

In the year 1896 (around 24 years) he completed his education and theological studies. He was ordained a Deacon by his father, the Bishop, and sent as a missionary of the Dublin University Mission to India – to Chota Nagpur Area, Central India. He worked in Ranchi / Hazaribag. It was while working in the Chota Nagpur Tribal Area that he turned to a **simple life with few wants** – being greatly influenced by missionaries like Charley Andrews and Majorie Sykes – great exponents and practitioners of astute and disciplined living.

He was ordained a Minister in 1901 in India at the Diocesan Cathedral, Ranchi by the Rt. Rev. Whitley, Bishop of Chota Nagpur and posted South as the Principal, SPG College, Trichy (later Bishop Neber College). Rev. Walsh developed this college to rival MCC at Madras. Students from Trichy, Tanjore and surrounding areas flocked to it for college education. He left a lasting impression on them.

From 1907 to 1913, he was posted to Bishop Cotton School, Bangalore. This school was then in a very miserable state. It is the sweat and toil of Rev. Walsh, who often worked as a labourer carrying stones on his shoulder, that the school was revived, stone by stone. The Bangalore posting (6 years) marked a change in the spiritual life of Rev. Walsh. He progressed closer to God. **He supplicated, fasted and prayed for perfection and the gift of healing** which he slowly achieved. It resulted in his great 'healing ministry'. He counted it part and parcel of his work as a 'Christian Minister'. He performed many miracles; but he never claimed it to himself nor did he claim to substitute the medical profession. His fame as a 'healer' began to spread. What the Lord gave, he freely gave to the poor and needy.

After his stint at Bangalore, Rev. Walsh was appointed Traveling Secretary, Church of England Missionary Society (CEMS) (1913-1915), in which capacity he toured India and became well acquainted with all the prominent Church / Mission leaders of the time, both Indian and foreign and their work.

In 1915 Calcutta Diocese was split into two, with a new diocese at Assam. Rev. Walsh was consecrated Lord Bishop of Assam in 1915 (at 44 years). Assam was a diocese only on paper; the poor Bishop had to work from scratch to build the diocese. It was hard work done with great personal involvement and dedication. He got married to Miss. Clara, who was an ideal wife and partner in his ministry.

In 1923, after 8 years of exhausting work as a Bishop, Bishop Walsh took up appointment as Principal, Bishop's College (Seminary), Calcutta. He taught scores of pastors, evangelists and bishops. His simple faith, humour, humility, great love and affection were greatly admired by his students. He was Principal up to 1935/36.

Bishop Walsh was very Indian in his thoughts and life. He had the **greatest sympathy for the Independence struggle**. He wrote many letters to England about the poor treatment meted out to the Indians. He warned that the British were losing ground in India.

In 1921 the first Christian Ashram (later called Christukula Ashram) was founded. This was an interesting development in Indian Christian Nationalism – this was greatly admired by Bishop Walsh. The Ashram life of service, sacrifice, the abdication of wealth and comforts, the meditation, evangelism, healing of the sick, etc. was to his liking. This prompted him to found an Ashram himself in 1936 when he was due to retire as Principal, Bishop's College, Calcutta being 64/65 years of age.

He turned to the National Missionary Society of India (NMSI) for help and advice. The NMSI had then a very great Ashram ministry. It had founded / was running the Christian Ashrams at Tirupattur, Angola (Karnataka) and Puri (Orissa). After much discussion, the Christukula Ashram Brothers, he and Mrs. Walsh decided the location of the Ashram – South India, near, but not too far away from the other Christian Ashrams. They settled on Thadagam (13 acres) near

Coimbatore, which was purchased out of his personal savings / retirement benefits. This was the humble beginning of the Christa Sishya Ashram, Thadagam in 1936 by the Bishop and some of his friends from the Syrian Orthodox Church. It began with huts and sheds. They were later modified and improved and affiliated with the NMSI. Bishop Walsh has very close association with the Christian Ashrams in India. He took part in the Silver Jubilee of the Christukula Ashram, Tirupattur in 1946 and was a frequent visitor to the Ashram.

Bishop Walsh's retired life at the Ashram with his Syrian Orthodox friends was a dedicated one – of **worship, prayer, meditation and service to God** in accordance with the Ashram constitution. He spread the gospel going by walk or bullock cart to interior villages. He prayed and healed many poor people, gradually becoming a great healer! His name and fame spread far and wide. However, he was a simple sadhu-like person with an almost divine look.

Bishop Walsh did a lot of touring. He addressed conferences, retreats, healing services and received hundreds of letters / requests for prayer, healing, solutions to problems, etc. He also wrote one of the outstanding books in the history of the Christian Church – Lights and Shades of Christendom.

Bishop Walsh died peacefully on 9.1.1949 at the age of 78 years. His wife died on 6.6.1961. They are buried in the Christa Sishya Ashram, which is now run by the Syrian Orthodox Church. Many miracles are attributed to those who visit and pray at his grave!
