A Word from the Pastor

Dearly Beloved,

Greetings to you in the most precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

As we are entering into the second month of 2012, we are reminded of God's faithfulness towards us. Last month we started the study of the book of Joshua. After Moses, Joshua made a remarkably smooth transition into leadership, through obedience and faithfulness unto God. There are many similar happenings in the life of Joshua which reminds us of Moses in the story of deliverance from Egypt towards the promise land. The miracle of crossing the Jordan river poignantly re-played Moses crossing the Red sea; Joshua met God's special representative, the "commander of the army of the Lord, "and likewise took off his shoes at the meeting (Joshua 5:13-15) as Moses encountered God directly at the burning bush; Both Joshua and Moses wrote the laws on the stones. Joshua erected monuments as they passed by occupying the promise land as Moses gave the Lord's statutes.

Both the leaders pleaded with God on behalf of their people. Joshua also gave a stirring farewell address and reviewed the history of deliverance and challenged them to be faithful to the Lord and serve Him, as Moses.

Through the study of the book of Joshua we are reminded of these following points.

Firstly, the faithfulness of God towards his chosen people. He was mindful of his promise to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and delivered them from the bondage from Egypt and led them to the land of Canaan, a land flowing with milk and honey. He provided them daily 'Manna' while they were traveling in the wilderness. The book of Joshua concludes that "not one of all the Lord's promises to the house of Israel failed, every one was fulfilled (Joshua 21:45) May the Lord fulfill all the promises in your lives also.

Secondly, God fought for them. It was the battle of the Lord. We see the familiar statement in the book of Joshua "Surely the Lord was fighting for Israel" (Joshua 10:14b). They captured Jericho,

of Amorites, because the battle belonged to God. Joshua captured southern and northern cities because God was with him. Whenever we have problems and burdens, let us submit to the Lord. In our spiritual battle, enable the Lord to fight for us because the battle belongs to the Lord.

Thirdly, Joshua was obedient at the core. After occupying the land of Canaan, he distributed it to the tribes of Israelites. God gave them peaceful years to live in the promise land from all their enemies. In his fare-well address he instructs them to be strong and to obey all that is written in the book of law of Moses.

He warns them not to serve other gods but to be faithful to him and

serve the Lord. “But if serving the LORD seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.”(Joshua 24:15), this saying is an inspiration and motivation for all the Christian families, to be faithful unto the Lord for the generations to come. May this be for you and your family. With these insights may the Lord help you to enter into the season of lent, as His chosen disciples.

May God bless you.

I will be with you all the while.*

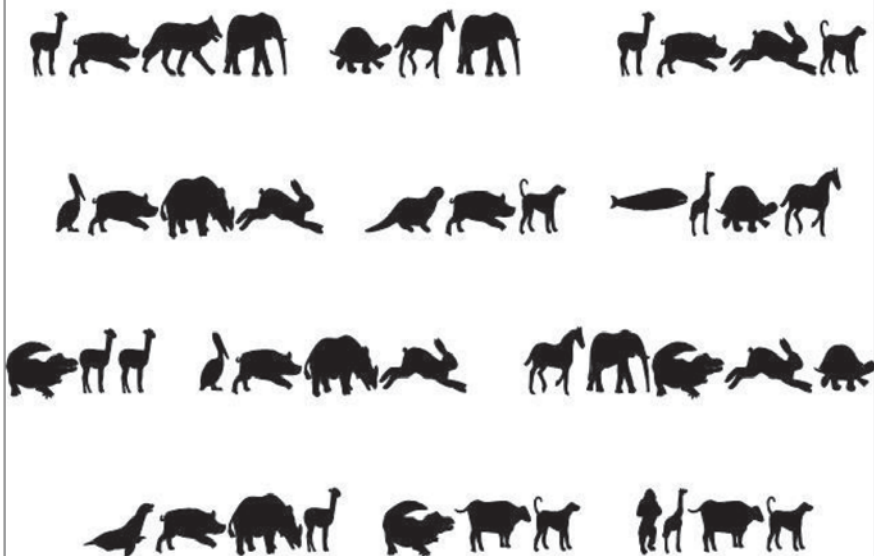
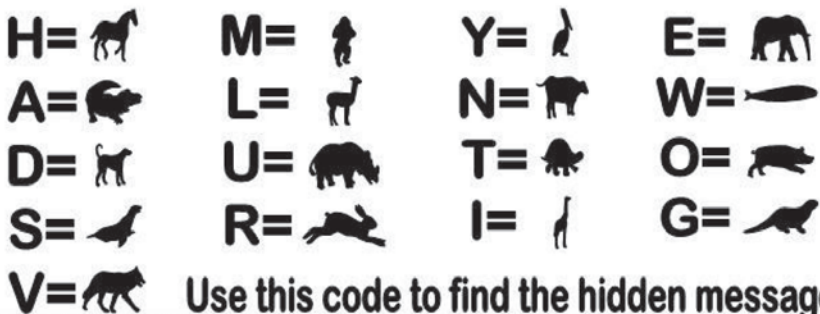

Your Question

Is it right for Christians to believe horoscopes, vastu and consult astrologers?

For those who want a simple answer, I would say, you do not need any of these things. The basic belief of astrology is that planets and stars exert an influence upon our lives. It is distressing that most major newspapers have a horoscope column, and even more distressing that many Christians read their horoscopes.

The Bible expressly forbids divination, sorcery, and hidden arts (Deut18:10-14). God's people are to heed God only (Deut 18:15). The Bible points to Jesus Christ as the only proper focus of faith (Acts 4:12; Hebrews 12:2). Our trust is in God alone, and we know that He will direct our paths (Pro 3:5-6). **Faith in anything besides God is misplaced and should be rejected by believers.**

Horoscope or vastu opposes biblical teaching in at least two ways: it advocates faith in something other than God, and it is a form of divination. We cannot determine God's will for our lives and homes through horoscopes and science. The Bible clearly says in Ps 127:1, 'Unless the Lord builds the house, its builder's labor in vain' and Heb 3:4, For every house is built by someone but God is the builder of everything. As Christians, we are to depend on God's Word in order to gain wisdom and guidance in regard to our future. I strongly believe that horoscopes, astrology and vastu should be rejected outright by those who believe in Christ because of the following Biblical reasons:

1. It is contrary to true faith in Jesus Christ and the teachings of the Bible
2. It exposes ourselves to the forces of darkness
3. It leads to deception and spiritual bondage
4. It is dangerous to our spiritual life
5. It is detestable to God
6. It is clearly wrong

God wants to bless us and give us protection. We also have his Word which is a lamp to our feet and light to our path (Psalm 119:105). We also have the Holy Spirit to lead us into all truth. Our God is with us all the time. Jesus said in Luke 10:19, I have given you authority to trample on scorpions and snakes and overcome the power of the enemy and nothing will harm you. So, let us not be afraid of anything in this world. Nothing can stand before us when we stand on the name of JESUS. Use the power of God that is in you. We should never follow the ways of the world and worldly people. God will bless you and your home abundantly if you are determined to follow the ways of the Lord.

RANDOM REFLECTIONS FROM A HOSPITAL BED AT MANIPAL, BANGALORE

CANDID OBSERVATIONS AND A PERSONAL TESTIMONY

1. With sporadic coughs and cold that just would not heal and after a whole night of a continuous bout of the same, on 6th November'11, with fever, I collapsed to the floor. Though fully conscious, I was unable to get up by myself. My wife Irene and my daughter Gladys helped me onto my bed.
2. Under God's guidance, Irene sensed that something serious had happened and decided to send me to the Manipal Hospital.
3. Early on Sunday morning, 7th Nov'11, the Hospital Ambulance arrived and I was carried down in a chair, unable to take even a step, though I was fully conscious.
4. I arrived at the Casualty Department where I was immediately attended to by doctors and nurses who first hooked me onto I.V. fluid and oxygen and checked on my pulse and blood pressure which had dropped pretty low. Irene & Gladys were then told that I was in a pretty serious condition. They wanted to know as to what had happened.
5. My doctor, Dr. Col. Isaac Mathew was informed of my arrival at Casualty and I was quickly whisked away to a semi-private room where I was given medical treatment as per Dr. Mathew's orders. X-rays of the chest confirmed a serious attack of pneumonia of the right lung and part of the left lung. C.T. scan of the brain and an echo test of the heart mercifully proved to be clear. I was totally lifeless at this point of time, and for a few days thereafter I was unable to get out of bed and I had no strength to use my hands to even feed myself.
6. Having worked as a Chaplain at the ETCM Hospital, Kolar, for 6 years and being familiar with hospital routine, I felt quite at home in my room; which was spotlessly clean and fresh. My room had a broad window through which I had an aerial view of Bangalore from the 5th floor level by day and night. There was a sea of greenery of trees with buildings at the far end which lit up the landscape at night. This reminded me of the Bangalore that I saw when I came here in 1942 from Calcutta. The whole of Bangalore looked like a paradise of flowering trees of red, yellow, pink and mauve colors. Gone are those days! I mention this, because to a patient who was sick and lying in bed, it did bring ray of joy, hope and healing as I enjoyed the creation of Almighty God. I was able to see the glorious sunset each evening. By night the scene changed to the glow of lights in various colors, shades and hues all around as far as I could see.
7. The Medical Team of my Doctor, Nurses and Medical Staff monitored me 24 hours. My doctor, Dr. Col. Isaac Mathew displayed a commanding, efficient and encouraging disposition which was a source of inspiration and confidence to me. He told Irene and Gladys, "don't worry, we'll put him back on his feet"! Sr. Jacinta was in charge of the ward with her colleagues Sr. Fernandes and Staff Nurses smartly uniformed, all of whom faithfully cared for me. All the medical and physical administration had to be completed by 11.00 a.m. when Dr. Col. Isaac Mathew with his team of doctors and nurses would be present for inspection and scrutiny to see if all was going well with the patient. After checking all the parameters and hearing the patients progress report and checking up on him, the doctor would make his observations to see that all "systems were go" and with a courteous greeting and encouraging words would leave.

8. I believe strongly in the theology of “Shalom” and of “Christian Fellowship. I’ve always said that, “of all life’s richest experience, Christian Fellowship is surely the best!” This is manifested in our lives in so many different ways that it would not be possible to exhaust the depth of it’s meaning just as the word “Shalom”. I was blessed to enjoy this Christian Fellowship during my stay at the hospital in so many different ways:-
- a) As Irene & Gladys ministered to me the beauty and bond of family life was made very real as to what relationships between parents and children and husband and wife mean. My son, Danny & daughter-in-law Daphne and the family were constantly in touch from Australia.
 - b) I had as my room-mate, an African couple. The moment they stepped in to the ward, they greeted us. I knew that there was something different about them. When they introduced themselves to us, they stated that they were Christians from Botswana, South Africa. We were pleased to introduce ourselves as fellow Christians, mentioning that I was a retired Methodist Pastor. They expressed their joy and happiness to know that we were also people of the faith, and Mr. Rutta said that it was a “coincidence” that brought us together. I told him that with God, there are no “coincidences” and that it was in His plan and purpose for both him and us to be in that Ward together so that we could be a blessing to each other. Mr. Rutta is a financial diplomat, touring around the world in his line of work and had come to Manipal Hospital for Neurosurgery. Talking about his work, his wife Magdalene complained that he was always working on his computer with his neck continuously bent and hence it may have been the cause of his problem. Mr. Rutta had a successful surgery in the neck region. He was taken to the Operation Theatre in the morning and was back in the ward by evening. We prayed both before and after surgery, Irene spent time in prayer with Magdalene during the time of surgery. His surgeon visited him often and sat with him prior to the surgery to explain the details of the same and encouraged him saying, ‘don’t worry, I’ve done a number of these procedures. You’ll be okay and you can travel home’, which he did a few days later. The next day he was walking around the corridors as part of the therapy. They are now back home in Botswana and we promised to keep in touch.
 - c) The medical team consisting of members of all faiths, worked round the clock with a sense of dedication and commitment. Some of them were Christians, including my doctor. It was touching to hear one of the nurses saying, “I pray for all my patients”! Part of my healing came because of the bonding I had with the team.
 - d) It was a blessing to have a few visitors after the initial period of illness, as also a small group of Senior Citizens and others who visited me at home and hospital. Many had expressed their desire of visiting me at the hospital but two factors were involved where that was not possible due to, firstly, my extreme weak condition and the strict monitoring of visitors by the hospital. I had therefore requested for all round prayers and I am grateful to the WSCS, Senior Citizens, Choirs and individuals, who were in prayer for me and contributed greatly towards

my healing. Please do continue to pray as I recuperate. I'm not out of the woods yet, but my health is improving day by day. I was also blessed because of the prayers of God's people at the Indiranagar, Koramangala and Richmond Town Methodist Churches and their pastors. Messages from time to time greatly encouraged me. My heart is always with you as I have happy memories of the fellowship we had when I was your Pastor in the early years of the life of the Church. I was the first Official Pastor of the Koramangala Methodist Church.

- e) It was a blessing to know that the Old Baldwinian Association upheld me in prayer at the Annual Red and Blue Nite on the 19th November'11 with Rev. Robin Paul leading in prayer. Mr. B. G. Koshy, the Chairman, was in touch with me from time to time. Mr. B. G. Koshy has been a good friend of mine over the years as we met at OBA functions and meetings and as we worked together for the Baldwin Schools and the Richmond Town Methodist Church.

I was very happy to note that there were old Baldwinians working as doctors at the Manipal Hospital. There is Dr. Shabeer Zaveri, Head of the Oncology Department. Earlier, attending the hospital for an appointment, there was suddenly an arm around my shoulder and a query, 'Sir, do you remember me? I was your student at Baldwins when you taught us Moral Science!' It took me a while to place him, as he was all grown up and then I recollected the young, bubbly, enthusiastic Shabeer Zaveri. What a joy it was to see him now after nearly 40 years, heading the Oncology Department as Surgeon Consultant. Then he asked, "what brings you here? Can I help in any way", and he did the needful for us.

Then again there was Dr. Ashwini from Customer Care, who visited me expressly to say that she was sent by her Head, Dr. Nagendra Swamy, another Baldwinian, who is the President & Chairman, Quality Council, Manipal Group, to enquire of my well-being.

I've got to close now. Trust that you have not been bored with this long episode, but it was my intention to share with you my personal feelings with a hope that in some way it may be a source of blessing to you. God's hand has been upon us at every step in a miraculous way in providing every facility. My doctor had said that it was by God's grace that I had overcome a serious crisis. I would like to add that, the care of my doctor and medical staff, the love and prayers of God's people far and wide, and the loving care of my wife Irene and my daughter Gladys greatly aided to my healing.

Above all, I see the hand of God in this crisis right from the beginning as He led us step by step. To Him be all praise and glory! Right now, I am on the mend and picking up my strength day by day. Please do continue to pray for me, Irene and Gladys. We continue to pray for you. Compliments of the season, and a Happy New Year. God bless you all.
