A Word from the Pastor

Dearly beloved,

Greetings to you in the most precious name of our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ.

This month our focus of meditation will be upon the "CROSS". For some, cross is just a symbol, an ornament which can be worn like a locket or any other fashionable material. For some, cross means nothing to them, in their belief or faith.

But for us, as Paul says in 1 Cor 1:18 "For the message of the Cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is power of God." During the inter-testament period, the Cross gained a means to punish the criminals with death penalty so that others may not dare to commit the same crime against the people or the government. To be hanged on the Cross was a prominent capital punishment in the Roman province. In Jerusalem also criminals and rebellions were punished by hanging on the Cross.

Jews around the world pilgrimaged to Jerusalem to celebrate the 'Pass-Over'. One among them was 'Simon of Cyrene'. He may be a visitor or a pilgrim from north

African city of Cyrene. He became a part of the historical happenings in the city of Jerusalem on that day. People were divided among themselves over "Jesus". Some felt that he was the long awaited "Messiah". But others considered Him as a false prophet. The religious leaders were successful in plotting his death. Simon of Cyrene was caught up in this commotion. On the day of Passover soldiers were leading the criminals towards 'Golgotha' amid the narrow streets of Jerusalem. Simon of Cyrene was a bystander, watching all these events. They were made to carry their own Crosses. One among them was "Jesus", who was so tried, drained out and was struggling to move forward. Impatient soldiers looked around the crowd to find someone to carry the Cross. They forced Simon of Cyrene to carry the Cross of Jesus. It might have been so embarrassing for him to carry the Cross. He might have reached till the place where Jesus was to be Crucified. Usually the criminals who were hanged used to shout, scold and say all sorts of nonsense to the people who punished them to be hanged. But Simon was astonished looking at the

person whose Cross he was carrying. He saw Jesus praying "Father forgive them for they know not what they are doing. There he gave his responsibility of taking care of his mother to the person who was standing near his Cross. Simon also saw him committing his spirit into the hands of the heavenly Father. He was convinced that he was really the messiah.

Later in the early history of the churches we see two young people who established the churches and were involved with the ministry. Paul names them 'Alexander and Rufus' the sons of Simon (Rom 16:30). The encounter of Jesus

on the way to Golgotha might have changed Simon and made him to dedicate his children for the ministry. How about you? Are you one among the crowd ? or like Simon of Cyrene who had "experienced the Lord". If you are not, we pray that during this lent season and the meditations upon the Cross may lead you to 'experience the Lord'.

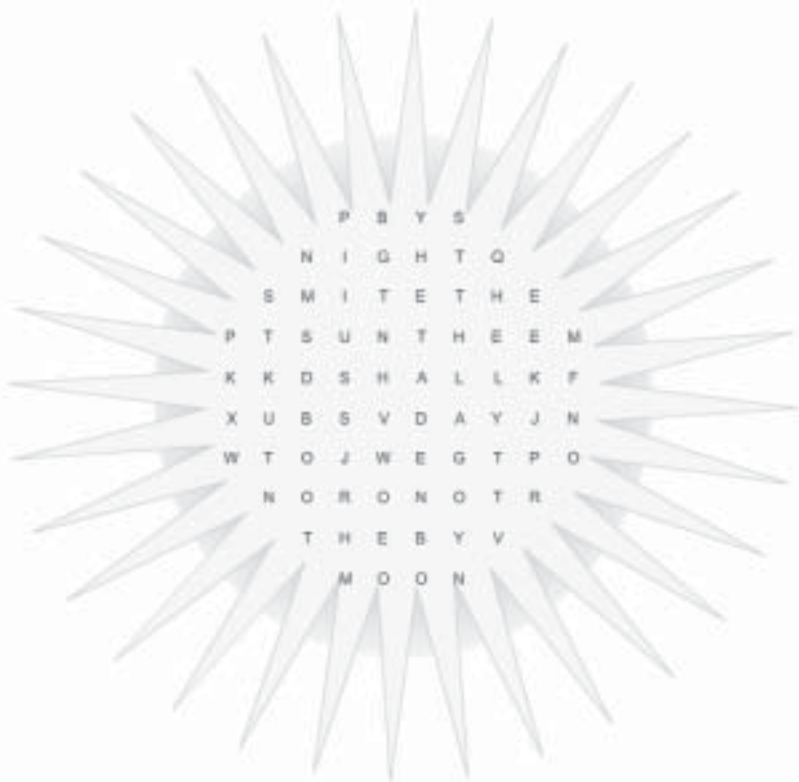

Your Question

What should I do for my Spiritual growth?

We had a fruitful group discussion on this question at the Airport Road Area fellowship on Feb 24. The members had a wonderful time of exchanging their views and insight and brought out some vital points to Spiritual growth. And at the end of the discussion we felt that we all struggle in living out the Word of God. And we prayed and decided to strive hard to follow Christ in every area of life in order to grow spiritually.

And I would like to list those points to our personal spiritual growth. 1. Faith in God in every situation 2. Be filled with the Fruit of the Spirit 3. Sincerity 4. Example to others 5. Witness for Christ 6. Accountability to God and others 7. Christian fellowship 8. Strong prayer life 9. Family prayer and meditation on God's word. 10. Fear of God 11. Urge to resist evil and temptation 12. Trying to be like Christ in every situation. 13. Doers of the Word.

Yes, all these points are familiar to all of us but the question is **Are we willing to commit our lives to do it?** We read in Heb 5:13-14- Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil. Spiritual growth is essential to the life of a Christian, just as physical growth is essential to the life of a child. Because God commands us to mature spiritually, we need to understand how that happens.

1. What we feed: According to Rom 7:14-25 and Gal 5:17-26 we all possess 2 natures. One before accepting Christ and another after. We call them old and new nature. The Old nature is fed by the system of the world and new nature is fed by the Holy Spirit. And the issue is which is fed more. Both natures fight together all the time in our mind and heart and the stronger one always wins. If we feed the old man we will do things against God. If we feed the new man more we will become closer to God and do things according to the Word of God. The new man is fed more effectively by obeying the word and practicing it. According to James it is useless to hear the word and fail to practice it (Jam 1:21-25). By listening and doing what the bible says we can easily avoid what the world says. As a result we can grow our new man.

2. What we value: We grow spiritually according to our own choice. What we choose is more important than what we do. We may be maintaining all the spiritual activities but our spiritual growth will depend upon what we value in life. Jesus says in Mat 6:21 where our treasure is there our heart also. The issue is what is the desire of our heart? What we treasure in life is very important. What we treasure will be manifested in due time (Lu 6:45). If we treasure sin, it will multiply when temptation comes but if we treasure the Word and God it will defeat and dominate sin and temptation. We need to check out our wants and wishes. Worldliness begins in the heart. King David committed sins yet he grew spiritually because his heart was with God (Ps 32, 51). To be a Christian means to be like Christ, not to be like someone. Knowing the teachings of Christ is not enough to grow spiritually, we must strive to follow. If we are not following Jesus we are not growing spiritually. Jesus should be our goal forever. Let's make a resolution to grow spiritually.

GOD PREPARES

Do you sometimes wonder why things always go wrong with you? Why circumstances are not in your favour most of the times? Why all this trouble – though you are the child of GOD?. I am sure all of us at one point or the other in life would have asked these questions to ourselves. Its not that, always we face problems in life, but when we face one – we are too quick to doubt GOD's goodness towards us.



A research about the differences between human beings and animals states - "Human beings have the unique intellect of reasoning, whereas animals don't. Maybe all animals know that fruits from a tree fall down to the ground, but only man knows why on ground and not towards sky!". Due to this wonderful GOD given intelligence (because He has created us in His own image Gen 1:27) we naturally tend to ask – "Why?" for everything that happens to us. I am glad GOD doesn't say - don't ask "why", but says find the answer in my "Word".

If you flip through the pages of the Living Bible from the beginning, even till the end – One can clearly perceive an interesting truth that – "GOD always wants to reveal more of Himself to mankind". He desires that man would understand and experience his mighty character and ensures that His beloved children know every facet of his divine nature.

Lets look at few passages from the Bible for a better understanding :
GOD proved his mighty power through miracles and rescued the Israelites from Egypt. **He prepared** a circumstance to portray His power, by hardening the heart of Pharaoh. If Pharaoh would have accepted Moses' appeal in the first attempt, there would have not been a need for those miracles. (Exodus 5-15)

Samson when cheated by Delilah – lost his great strength and became a prisoner. Helpless blind Samson was forced to entertain the great Philistine gathering for fun. And when he prayed to GOD - he regained his strength and killed himself along with all the Philistines in one go (The number of Philistines he killed at his death was more than what he killed during his entire life span). **GOD did prepare** a circumstance to prove Samson that his strength was not from his unshaved hair, but by GOD himself. (Judges 16)

GOD prepared a fish to save Jonah, when he was cast into the sea. Further, **GOD also prepared** a leafy plant, a worm and a vehement east wind to admonish the angry prophet. (Jonah 1-4)

GOD prepared a Goliath so as to enthrone his servant David. (I Samuel 17)

Lord Jesus allowed the death of Lazarus His friend, so as to **prepare** a situation where He can raise him from the dead. Hence He proved his strength to Martha, Mary and all the people of Bethany. (John 11)

And I strongly believe **GOD prepared** a storm, so that he could calm it and strengthen the faith of His disciples. (Matt 8:23-27)

And the list goes on ...

Dearly beloved – Let us be reminded that GOD has a wonderful plan for us. (Jer 29:11)

- How would you know, GOD can heal – if you never fell sick?"
- How would you know, GOD comforts - if you never were sad?"
- How would you know, GOD is gracious – If you would have never sinned?"

A REPORT FROM HOSAMANE MISSION FIELD

On the 04 of February 2012, we went with 24 people including 2 children to Hosamane Mission Field, located on the Mangalore Highway. The Mission Field is formed by KEA, with Head Quarters situated at Hennur Road. We would like to share on how the Missionary couple Mrs. & Mr. David are strategically working along with the Children and the others in 7 villages.

Currently, they provide breakfast for more than 65 children from Monday to Friday and every Saturday the children are given dinner too. They also arrange medical camp for sick people.

The missionaries go to the nearby village, identify people who are in need and invite them to their community development centre and share the gospel and pray with them.

On Saturday afternoon at 2.30 pm, the children were all gathered and Mrs. Jayamma and Mrs. Jamuna Jaisingh took a session of singing songs and telling Bible stories. After that Mr. Naveen Chandra (a Brahmin convert) shared a Bible story and shared his personnel testimony with the children. Then, late in the evening the missionary couple took us to a nearby village called Ramanathnagar for a prayer meeting in one of the believers' home. We had a blessed time singing Kannada songs and learning the word of God along with the believers of Ramanathnagar.

The next day, early in the morning Mrs. Jamuna and her team went to visit the nearby houses and invited them to come and attend the Sunday worship service. At 9.30 am the children came for Sunday school and Mrs. Jamuna and Mrs. Jayamma took the session in Kannada. All the children were fully involved in singing with action and dancing and also telling the memory verses. Then, Mr. Devanand started the worship service along with the missionary. The church was full and Mr. Rathod delivered the Lord's message in Kannada. Then time was given for testimony, many came forward and gave their testimonies as to how the Lord almighty had heard their prayers and answered their prayers. Soon after the service got over, Mr. Devanand asked if anyone wanted someone to pray for their personal needs; at once many people came and from our group 10 people stood and prayed for each one according to their needs... It was such a wonderful experience for us all.

Our main task from this visit is to pray regularly for their mission work to grow. We all live in our own comfort zones not knowing many things about the mission field or how the gospel is every day reaching the unreached people. So could we all please pray for them?
