A Word from the Pastor

Dearly beloved in Christ,

Greetings to you in the most precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

This month our focus of meditations will be on the “Holy Spirit”. This is a vast subject. May God anoint us and reveal the hidden treasures of His word to know the doctrine of the Holy Spirit in a deeper sense.

We believe in **Triune God** i.e. **God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit**. To understand God we need to study God the Father, His son Jesus Christ, the saviour and redeemer and the ‘Holy Spirit’ who is the comforter and the counsellor.

It is essential that we recognize the importance of the Holy Spirit in God’s redemptive purpose. Many Christians have no idea what difference it would make if there was no **Holy Spirit** in this world, without the Holy Spirit there would be no creation, no universe, no human race (Genesis 1:2; Job 33:4) without the Holy Spirit there would be no Bible (2 Peter 1:2) no new testament

(John 14:26, 15: 26-27; I Corinthians 2:10-14, no power to proclaim the gospel (Acts 1:8) without the Holy spirit there would be no faith, no new birth, no holiness, no Christians at all in this world. The Holy Spirit is active along with the **Father** and the **Son** from the creation of the world to this day and to the end of this world.

The early church experienced the manifestation of the Holy Spirit in the form of ‘**fire**’ on the Pentecost day. Let us praise the Lord for the faithful ministry of regeneration (reborn) by the spirit (John 3).

Romans 8:13 says “if by the spirit you put to death the deeds of the body you will live” – The principle that nothing lives unless something else dies extends beyond nature to our daily walk with God. Interests of the flesh must succumb to the interest of the spirit or else the interest of the spirit will succumb to the interest of the flesh. In the jungles and fields and streams of our own heart, something must always die so that something else can live.

We cannot be committed to Christ and to the world at the same time. We can't be filled with the Holy Spirit if we are protecting the life of selfish interests. That's why our Lord said that we will need to die daily to ourselves. If we are going to walk with Him (Luke 9:23-24) we must continually choose, what will have to die, so that Christ can live freely in us. We need to allow the Holy Spirit to transform our lives and make us like Jesus.

Jesus has warned us in Matthew 12:31, 32 "And so I tell you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men but the blasphemy against the spirit will not be forgiven. Anyone who speaks a word against the son of man will be forgiven, but anyone

who speaks against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven, either in this age or in the age to come." Let us not sin against the Holy Spirit, Let us not "quench the spirit" (I Thessalonians 5:19-20) or 'grieve' not the Holy Spirit in and through our Christian living (Ephesians 4:30).

May the Spirit of the Lord enable all of us to understand the '**Holy Spirit**'. If you have Jesus as your Lord and Saviour, then you have also the "**Holy Spirit**" of God with you.

RESURRECTION – Fake or Fact?

Skeptic Answers

If Jesus did rise from the dead then he alone would have the answers to what life is about and what is facing us after we die. On the other hand, if the resurrection account of Jesus is not true, then Christianity would be founded upon a lie. Theologian *R. C. Sproul* puts it this way:

“The claim of resurrection is vital to Christianity. If Christ has been raised from the dead by God, then He has the credentials and certification that no other religious leader possesses. Buddha is dead. Mohammad is dead. Moses is dead. Confucius is dead. But, according to...Christianity, Christ is alive.”

Many skeptics have attempted to disprove the resurrection. *Josh McDowell* was one such skeptic who spent more than seven hundred hours researching the evidence for the resurrection. McDowell stated this regarding the importance of the resurrection:

“I have come to the conclusion that the resurrection of Jesus Christ is one of the most wicked, vicious, heartless hoaxes ever foisted upon the minds of men, OR it is the most fantastic fact of history.”

So, is Jesus’ resurrection a fantastic fact or a vicious myth? To find out, we need to look at the evidence of history and draw our own conclusions. Let’s see what skeptics who investigated the resurrection discovered for themselves.

Something Happened

But it wasn’t the end. The Jesus movement did not disappear (obviously), and in fact Christianity exists today as the world’s largest religion. Therefore, we’ve got to know what happened after Jesus’ body was taken down from the cross and laid in the tomb.

In a *New York Times* article, *Peter Steinfels* cites the startling events that occurred three days after Jesus’ death: “Shortly after Jesus was executed, his followers were suddenly galvanized from a baffled and cowering group into people whose message about a living Jesus and a coming kingdom, preached at the risk of their lives, eventually changed

an empire. Something happened.... But exactly what?” That’s the question we have to answer with an investigation into the facts.

There are only five plausible explanations for Jesus’ alleged resurrection, as portrayed in the New Testament:

1. Jesus didn’t really die on the cross.
2. The “resurrection” was a conspiracy.
3. The disciples were hallucinating.
4. The account is legendary.
5. It really happened.

Let’s work our way through these options and see which one best fits the facts. [only *one option is mentioned here*]

The Matter of an Empty Tomb

No serious historian really doubts Jesus was dead when he was taken down from the cross. However, many have questioned how Jesus’ body disappeared from the tomb. English journalist, *Dr. Frank Morison*, initially thought the resurrection was either a myth or a hoax, and he began research to write a book refuting it. The book became famous but for reasons other than its original intent, as we’ll see.

Morison began by attempting to solve the case of the empty tomb. The tomb belonged to a member of the Sanhedrin Council, Joseph of Arimathea. In Israel at that time, to be on the council was to be a rock star. Everyone knew who was on the council. Joseph must have been a real person. Otherwise, the Jewish leaders would have exposed the story as a fraud in their attempt to disprove the resurrection. Also, Joseph’s tomb would have been at a well-known location and easily identifiable, so any thoughts of Jesus being “lost in the graveyard” would need to be dismissed.

Morison wondered why Jesus’ enemies would have allowed the “empty tomb myth” to persist if it wasn’t true. The discovery of Jesus’ body would have instantly killed the entire plot.

And what is known historically of Jesus’ enemies is that they accused Jesus’ disciples of stealing the body, an accusation clearly predicated on a shared belief that the tomb was empty.

Dr. Paul L. Maier, professor of ancient history at Western Michigan University, similarly stated, “If all the evidence is weighed carefully and fairly, it is indeed justifiable ... to conclude that the tomb in which Jesus was buried was actually empty on the morning of the first Easter. And no shred of evidence has yet been discovered ... that would disprove this statement.”

The Jewish leaders were stunned, and accused the disciples of stealing Jesus’ body. But the Romans had assigned a 24-hour watch at the tomb with a trained guard unit (from 4 to 12 soldiers). Morison asked, “How could these professionals have let Jesus’ body be vandalized?” It would have been impossible for anyone to have slipped by the Roman guards and to have moved a two-ton stone. Yet the stone was moved away and the body of Jesus was missing.

If Jesus’ body was anywhere to be found, his enemies would have quickly exposed the resurrection as a fraud. Tom Anderson, former president of the California Trial Lawyers Association, summarizes the strength of this argument:

“With an event so well publicized, don’t you think that it’s reasonable that one historian, one eye witness, one antagonist would record for all time that he had seen Christ’s body? ... The silence of history is deafening when it comes to the testimony against the resurrection.”

So, with no body of evidence, and with a known tomb clearly empty, Morison accepted the evidence as solid that Jesus’ body had somehow disappeared from the tomb.

Not Just “Having Church”

It occurs to me that many churches “do church” pretty well: warm greetings are given, God-honouring music is played, soul-stirring singing is enjoyed, concerns are shared, prayers are offered and God’s word is set forth. And, oh yes, I almost forgot, an offering is taken too.

Yes, with all those elements in place, I would say that settles it, most local gatherings of Jesus’ disciples “do church” pretty well.

It also occurs to me that one could come faithfully to Sunday morning gatherings, have gotten involved in “going to church”, consistently be there when they “have church” - when those infamous “doors are opened” - without behaving as a vital member of the church.

Notice I did NOT say become a member of church, as in “join a church”. Instead, I wrote of “behaving as a vital member of the church.” Simply put, that means “being the church”.

Sadly, its not rare for someone to be faithful in “going to church” without functioning as an active part of the church. Most sadly of all is that many faithful church people seem sufficiently satisfied to exist as faithful church attendees with no more input or contact than a shared Sunday morning “worship / church experience”.

An analogy from the theater world may help show the difference between attendees and vital participants. At a play, no one would confuse the audience with the cast. Seeing a play - even dozens of times - is quite different from learning lines, designing costumes or painting sets. Going to a play does not make you a vital member of the production - as important as an audience is.

Unfortunately, this is a troublesome analogy as many times our Sunday gathering (“church”) is now evaluated by how well we “put on the show” on Sunday morning. “How was church” has come to mean “did the choir sing nice, did the preacher go long, was the room stuffy, the music too loud...?”. The church is the people, not the program.

A better analogy might be the difference between being a hat and a hand. The hat is a nice addition and adornment to one's body. The hand is a vital attachment, a crucial functioning part. So too simply being a mere faithful attendee versus being an integral part in a local body - more than just Sundays and church held programs.

The passage most often used to exhort faithful attendance from God's people is Hebrews 10:24-25. Who has not heard this "forsake not the assembling of yourselves together" passage countless times? Yet, the plea in the text is for faithfulness in showing up so that we can all encourage one another - and even more as we see His return getting closer.

We have lowered the bar. We have set sitting as a sufficient - and for some - supreme standard. Yet, this Hebrews passage asserts that we are to give careful thought as to how we can spur on one another to love and good deeds. Just think if we gave this as much careful consideration as we did what we wore, where we sat, and where we would eat after church.

More than just being "in your place on Sunday morning", we are to take our place of mutually edifying and exhorting one another (see Ephesian 4:11-16; 1 Corin 12:12 ff, Rom. 12, Acts 2:42-47).

Hats abound - per my last analogy. We celebrate how many hats are present at "church". However, "hands down" - sorry - it is the hands that count.

Here is a challenge: instead of simply requiring of yourself that you "go to church", demand from yourself that you function as part of the church. This will still include going to church, but it will include so much more: serving those in need, using your Spirit-given gifts to build up the body, being in growing relationships with other followers of Jesus, spurring others on in their walk...

To further mix the metaphor, it is time for all "hands" on deck.

The church is those people who have been called out of the world by God to Himself. Church is not something you have, a place you go or a service conducted on Sunday. Church is something you are a part of. We are to "be the church", to the glory of God, not just go to church or have church.

Hence Evangelist Oral Roberts rightly said – “Never doubt JESUS, doubt your ‘Doubts’”.

LORD JESUS is the same –yesterday, today and forever (**Heb 13:8**). He has not changed. If he could heal 2000 yrs ago, he even heals today. Never miss the chance to stretch out your hand in FAITH and touch the hem of his precious garment – AND BE HEALED!
